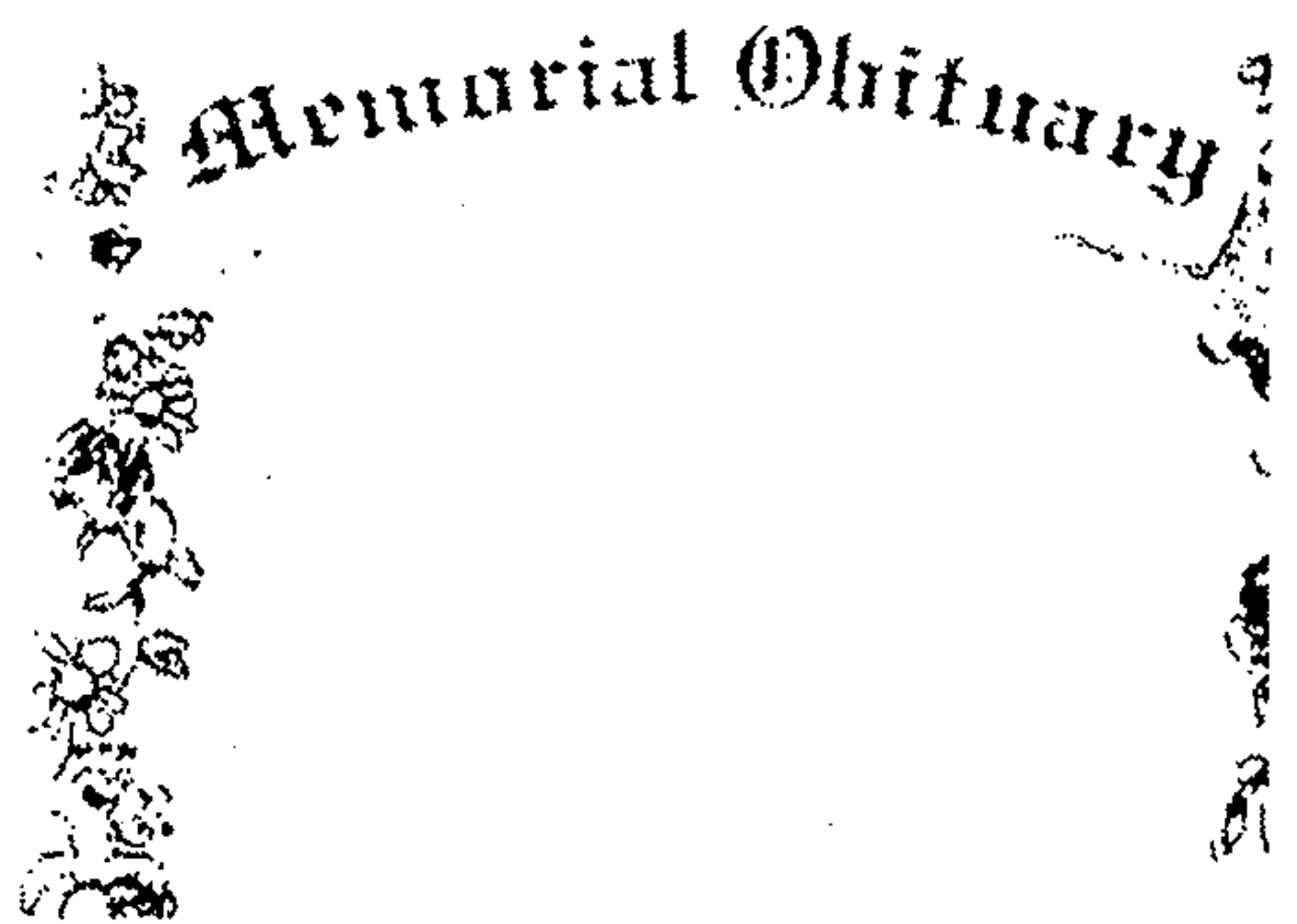


OBERTO
