5 undersigned, did on the 22 day of July A.D. 1880 claim
6 by right of Location under Sec. 2323 Revised statutes
7 of the United States act may 10 A.D. 1872, Three Thousand
8 feet in length on the Pride of the West Tunnel Site
9 Situated in Monarch Mining District Chaffee County
10 State of Colorado, the Location and line of said tunnel
11 is more fully described as follows to wit: Beginning at
12 the Tunnel Face situated at the West side of the Great
13 Basin at the head of the North Fork of the South Arkansas
14 River, whence North Fork Locating monument bears East 0°
15 $26'$ North distant 2491 feet. Running thence North $72^{\circ} 32'$
16 West (Variation $15^{\circ} E$) 742 feet to the main shaft on Pride
17 of the West Lode 2595 feet to Summit of Pomeroy Mountain
18 3000 feet to the West end whence a post the South East
19 corner of Silver Cloud Lode bears $S 11^{\circ} N$, distant 56
20 feet and the upper Chalk Creek Lake bears South 24°
21 $15'$ West. Said Tunnel Line is marked on the surface
22 of the Ground with a stake at each 100 foot point and
23 a substantial post at each 500 foot Point proposed height
24 of Tunnel $7\frac{1}{2}$ feet, width 5 feet. The Excavation at the face
25 of the Tunnel is 22 feet long and $14\frac{1}{2}$ feet breast, said
26 Tunnel is Located and is to be prosecuted for the Disc-
27 overy of all veins or lodes within Three Thousand feet
28 from the face of said Tunnel on the Line thereof not
29 previously known to exist and for the improvement
30 and development of the Pride of the West Lode

9 was begun thereon Aug. 9th A.D. 1880 that he has ex-
10 pended in work thereon the Sum of Four hundred
11 Dollars (\$400) that the Said work consists of an excavation
12 at the face of the Tunnel 22 feet long and 14 1/2 feet
13 breast and of a Tunnel 7 1/2 feet high and 5 feet wide
14 30 feet in length that the Line of said tunnel is marked
15 on the surface of the Ground with stakes at Each 100 ft
16 Point and substantial posts at Each 500 ft Point clearly
17 defining the course of said tunnel that it is his bona
18 fide intention to to prosecute work on the tunnel so
19 Located with reasonable diligence for the discovery of
20 all veins or lodes within Three Thousand feet from the
21 face of Said Tunnel on the line thereof not previo-
22 usly known to exist and for the development of the
23 Pride of the West Lode.
